

Chapter Twenty-Two (c): Restoring a Backup File

Summary of Chapter:

- How to restore a backup file onto your Pilot.

What you need:

- Knowledge of Admin user account and valid password for your Pilot.
- A saved backup file on your computer's hard-drive, which is Version 5.

Software Revision Required:

- Applicable to software revision 5.2.0 > Net/CachePilots

(Net/CachePilot will be referred to as 'Pilot'. All image examples are of a NetPilot.)

Restoring a Backup file:

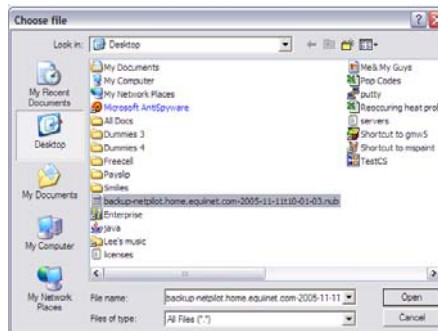
- Log on to the Pilot as shown in Chapter One (b).
- From the left-hand side of the screen, select 'System backup' and then 'Restore backup'. (All links are highlighted below).



- You will be presented with the screen shown left.

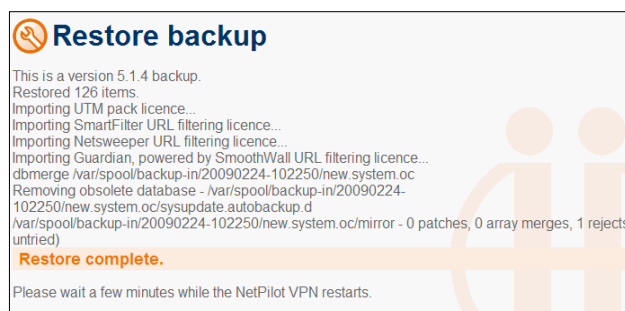
- Select the 'Browse' button, as highlighted.

- You will see the below window:



- Select the backup file and select the 'Open' button.

- Once you have selected the file, select the 'OK' button on the Pilot. You will then see a similar screen shown below:



- After loading the backup file, which may take a few minutes depending on its size, the Pilot will restart.
