

Chapter Seven (j): Time Bands

Summary of Chapter:

- How to change the Time bands on your Pilot.

What you need:

- Knowledge of Admin user account and valid password for your Pilot

Software Revision Required:

- Applicable to software revision 5.2.0 > Net/CachePilots

(Net/CachePilot will be referred to as 'Pilot'. All image examples are of a NetPilot.)

Time bands:

- Log on to the Pilot as shown in Chapter One (b).

- From the left-hand side of the screen, select 'Time and date' and then 'Time bands'. (All links are highlighted below).



- In the above screen, you have the options to add, edit or delete 'Time bands'.

- These options are explained in further detail below.

Add:

- Once you have selected the 'Add' button, you will be presented with the screen below:

- 'Time band name': Enter a new name.

- 'Days': Unselected the days you do not want included in this 'Time band'.

- 'Hours': Select the scheduled time you would like your 'Time band' to included.

- Select 'OK' and 'OK' again to confirm settings.

Edit:

☺ Choose the 'Time band' you wish to edit from the list provided, and then select the 'Edit' button, as highlighted below:
