

## Chapter Eight (a): Adding a Static Route

### Summary of Chapter:

- How to add a static route to your Pilot

### What you need:

- Knowledge of Admin user account and valid password for your Pilot.
- A name for the static route, IP and Mask address and the interface you would like to send the routed packets to.

### Software Revision Required:

- Applicable to software revision 5.2.0 > Net/CachePilots

(Net/CachePilot will be referred to as 'Pilot'. All image examples are of a NetPilot.)

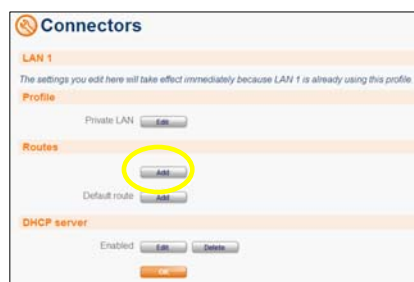
### Adding a Static Route:

- Log on to the Pilot as shown in Chapter One (b).
- From the left-hand side of the screen, select 'Network' and then 'Connectors'. (All links are highlighted below).



- Select the 'Edit' button of the profile you want to add a static route to.

- You will be presented with a similar screen as below.



- Select the 'Add' button under 'Routes' as highlighted left.

- You will be presented with the below screen, enter in the relevant details:

- 'Name': A name, this must not contain any special characters.
- 'Address': IP address
- 'Address Mask': address mask you would like to route to.
- 'Gateway': Gateway you would like to use.
- 'Trust group': Select a Trust Group from the drop down list. (For a definition of each of these Trust Groups please see the first section of Chapter 5).

- Once you have entered the correct details select 'OK' and 'OK' again to confirm.
